<u>ACKNOWLEDGMENT</u> of receipt of the application forms and confirmation of reservation is made from this office to the <u>sponsor or school patrol chairman only</u> - <u>NOT TO THE PARENTS except in the case of ALUMNI campers</u>.

<u>DIRECTIONS:</u> Located on North Long Lake about 8 miles northeast of Brainerd. About 5 miles north of Brainerd on Highway 3 is a "LEGIONVILLE" sign. Turn west at this sign, (County Road 119) and continue for about 2 miles. The "LEGIONVILLE" entrance is marked. North of Brainerd on Highway 371, exit at County Road 49 and go east about 4 miles, turn left on Smith Road for about 2 miles, then turn left on Legionville Road. The address for Legionville is 9544 Legionville Road, Brainerd, MN 56401

<u>TRANSPORTATION:</u> This is the responsibility of the parents or sponsors. We recommend car pools and chartered buses to help cut costs.

ARRIVAL TIME: Trainees must arrive between 2:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. on Sunday. The <u>FIRST</u>

MEAL SERVED ON SUNDAY IS 5:00 P.M. SUPPER. A tour of the Training Center, banking procedures, and Dining Hall routines are all accomplished before supper. Your arrival before 4:00 P.M. will facilitate a smooth schedule. Money will be checked in at the camp bank during registration. TRAINEES WISHING TO BUNK TOGETHER SHOULD ARRIVE TOGETHER!!

Notification of arrival time is not necessary unless trainee is arriving after 4:00 PM.

DEPARTURE TIME: All trainees MUST check out at the Administration Office before leaving the grounds. Parents, guardians, sponsors, drivers, etc. are encouraged to come to Legionville on Friday afternoon for our camp graduation ceremony at 2:00 P.M.
