Applications for reservations for 2019 Legionville School Safety Patrol Training Center at Brainerd, Minnesota are now being accepted by The American Legion, Department of Minnesota, 20 W. 12th St., Room 300A, St. Paul, Minnesota 55155-2000.

We offer 2 programs for campers. Patrol Campers and Alumni Campers. Patrol Campers are campers who have not attended Legionville before. Alumni campers are campers who have attended Legionville within the past 3 years **OR campers that were scheduled for the 2018 summer but were unable to attend due to the cancellation of camp.**

☆ **PATROL CAMPER** - The fee is **\$285.00** per PATROL CAMPER and must accompany the “Request for Reservation” form. **PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO LEGIONVILLE.** Any student that is hoping to be or scheduled to be a member of their school safety patrol program is eligible to attend as a Patrol Camper. Your “Request for Reservation” must also designate the number of boys and the number of girls for whom fees are being remitted, as well as the sessions requested. (Please make sure an alternate session is noted on the registration form). It is necessary that we receive this information in order to make a reservation for you. All seven sessions will be co-ed again this year. Patrol Campers can attend any session EXCEPT Session 3 which is reserved for Alumni Campers only. Kindly fill in the name of the school(s) from which you will be sponsoring patrol members.

Reservations are on a first come first served basis. Please do not hold this reservation application until you have the names of the school PATROL CAMPERS. We do not need the names at this time and you may lose your first choice of sessions. The purpose of the application is to insure that a place will be reserved for your student(s) in the session(s) you select. The name(s) will be added to your reservation after we have received the completed registration forms.

Patrol members who will be 10 years old before September 1st and not older than 13 years will be eligible to attend the training center program. **Exceptions are allowed but should be cleared ahead of time through our St. Paul office.**

Please note that the above policy derives from the 1990 Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 120.06, Subdivision (1).

☆ **ALUMNI CAMPER** – The fee is **\$285.00** per PATROL CAMPER and must accompany the “Request for Reservation” form. **PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO LEGIONVILLE.** **Parents or Guardians will complete this enclosed reservation form. Copy it as needed and send it home with the ALUMNI CAMPER applicant. We will work directly with the parent or guardian to complete any ALUMNI CAMPER reservations. Session 3 is reserved for Alumni Campers only.** However, ALUMNI CAMPERS can attend any session EXCEPT Session 7. The fee would remain the same and they would participate in the same activities and classes as their previous visit. **** PLEASE NOTE - A minimum of 13 campers is required to hold Session 3 which is reserved for only alumni campers. If 13 alumni campers are not signed up by June 1st, the session will be canceled and registration fees will be refunded in full.**

JUNIOR COUNSELOR – Each session we have a limited number of spaces available for junior counselors. Please contact Legionville directly if a returning camper over the age of 13 would like to serve as a junior counselor.
