



# Consolidated Post Report

- This is a report that is used by National to report to Congress all the things the American Legion is doing. It is the American Legion's "Report Card". This is due to the National Headquarters by July 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and covers the period of May 1 to Apr 30.
- This report can be updated numerous times, allowing you to report after each event or monthly or however you wish to keep track.
- Something needs to be updated on this form, it cannot be sent in blank. Does the Post Have a Color Guard? Did the Post participate in Veterans Day, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July? These are all items that can be included on this report.

Find the area that you need to edit, select the edit button next to that area and update the information. You can just exit out of here and your information will be saved, or you can “Save and Submit”. If you just exit out, don’t forget to come back and “Save and Submit” or your report will ne be sent to National.

### CPR Report

Click **Edit** in each category to enter your Post Report data. After you've completed the form, click the **Save and Submit** button to save changes and submit your file to National Headquarters. After submitting, you can print a copy for your files by clicking on the **Generate PDF** button when it appears. If you discover an error or need to change or add information after submitting the report, you can make the updates and re-submit the form again as long as it done prior to the cut-off on July 1st; it will simply replace the previously submitted report on file. Keep in mind that your Department Headquarters will also receive a copy of each report you submit so make sure your CPR is complete and accurate before you submit it to help minimize confusion.

Please note, you can enter partial data in the report and sign out without completing the entire form, and the data you entered will be saved. This is helpful as you gather information from different officers or leaders by giving you the option to enter the information as it's received or waiting until you have it all compiled and completing the CPR in one session.

If your post had projects, activities or events which cannot be adequately covered on the report form, please use the button marked "Update miscellaneous text field" to describe these -- using no more than 1,024 characters.
